1. Assume the character of Bilbo Baggins. You will **keep a journal as the character of Bilbo**. Be creative and make a cover for Bilbo’s journal or purchase a unique journal. You can even make a cover that looks leather or worn. The design is up to you. Have fun with it!

\*You will **write an entry for each chapter of the book** (19 chapters). Each journal should be approximately 5 sentences or longer and record what Bilbo might be thinking or feeling at that point in the story. Be sure to show the characteristics of Bilbo and do not only summarize the book. Remember ... the journal is written from Bilbo’s point of view.

\***Make sure you bring your journal with you to class on the first day of school.**
