

Elementary Supply Lists

Please bring all supplies on the first day of school. Label all belongings and supplies with your child's name before bringing them to school. In addition to general supplies, please check below for specific grade level supplies.

Kindergarten

- Backpack (without wheels)
- Small lunch box, no coolers please
- Non-marking athletic shoes for PE and indoor recess (These are not to be worn outside and will be kept at school)
- Headphones or earbuds, labeled and stored in a ZipLoc bag (for computer use)
- 8 tennis balls cut with an "X" for chair and desk legs (floor protectors)
- 2 - 5" x 8" pencil boxes
- 1 package Ticonderoga #2 pencils, sharpened
- 1 pink chubby eraser
- 1 box 8 Crayola brand large markers
- 2 boxes 24 Crayola crayons
- 6 school glue sticks (Elmer's or Scotch brands)
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- 1 pair safety scissors
- 2 primary journals, 200 pages (Mead Writing Fundamentals Primary Journal K-2nd grade Primary Writing 3 stage)
- 1 beach towel, labeled
- 2 boxes tissues

- 2 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 Tacky glue (for Art class)
- 2 pack wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 package lined 4 x 6 index cards
- 2 sewn Composition book (NOT spiral)

Fourth Grade

- Backpack (without wheels)
- Small lunch box, no coolers please
- Non-marking athletic shoes for PE and indoor recess (These are not to be worn outside and will be kept at school)
- 3 boxes tissues (2 for classroom, 1 for science)
- 2 rolls paper towels (1 for classroom, 1 for science)
- 1 large container anti-bacterial wipes

- Headphones or earbuds, labeled and stored in a ZipLoc bag (for computer use)
- 1 zipper pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- 1 small pencil sharpener (hand-held)
- 2 packages Ticonderoga #2 pencils, sharpened
- 2 small boxes colored pencils (10-24), sharpened (label one for **science lab**; it will be kept in lab)
- 1 box 24 crayons, no larger please
- 2 pencil erasers
- 1 black ballpoint pen
- 2 fine point dry erase low odor markers, any color
- 1 small dry-eraser
- 2 pairs scissors (one pair will be left in science lab)
- 2 rolls Scotch tape (one roll will be left in science lab)
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks
- 12" ruler with inches and centimeters (hard plastic or wooden)
- 2 sewn Composition book (NOT spiral) for Foreign Language and Devotions
- 1 graph composition SEWN notebook (usually found as 5x5 graph ruled)—about 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for labs (NOTE: This will be used for the next few years in science class)
- 1 spiral notebooks for science
- 1 packages wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 one-inch 3-ring binder with pockets (with "tabs" to open the rings) Please be sure this binder has pockets
- 1 package divider tabs for binder
- 1 RED plastic folder with pockets (labeled "FRIDAY FOLDER")
- 1 BLUE plastic folder with pockets (labeled "DAILY FOLDER TO GO HOME")
- 1 GREEN plastic folder with pockets (labeled "CLASS WORK")
- 1 PURPLE plastic folder with prongs and pockets (labeled "SCIENCE")

IF YOUR LAST NAME BEGINS WITH:

- A-M bring 1 8 oz. bottle waterless hand sanitizer
- N-Z bring 1 boz Ziploc bags, any size

Fifth Grade

- Backpack (without wheels)
- Small lunch box, no coolers please
- Non-marking athletic shoes for PE and indoor recess (These are not to be worn outside and will be kept at school)
- Headphones or earbuds, labeled and stored in a ZipLoc bag (for computer use)
- 3 sewn composition books (NOT spiral or glued)
- 1 graph composition SEWN notebook (usually found as 5x5 graph ruled)—about 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for labs (NOTE: This will be used for the next few years in science class **(If you were in 4th grade at TCS last year this was kept in the lab for you to use in 5th grade)**)
- 4 single-subject spiral bound notebooks, college ruled (3 for classroom, one for science lab)
- 1 package College ruled notebook paper

- Three 1" 3-ring binders (1 must be BLACK for Science Fair)
- 2 packages 5-6 pocket dividers for a 3-ring binder (one for classroom, one for science)
- 1 vinyl folder any color for classroom (2 pockets)
- 1 purple plastic folder with prongs and pockets – labeled Science
- Page protectors (not needed until after Christmas for Nations Project)
- TI-30XA calculator (you will use this up through 8th grade in Science) *** please, be sure to purchase this model – they are about \$10 at Walmart – this will be kept in the lab in a bin – LABEL it with your name
- 4" x 6" index cards
- Pencil pouch that fits in binder
- 2 red ballpoint pens
- 2 highlighters
- 1 BLACK sharpie to be used in science lab
- 2 small boxes (12-24) colored pencils (one for classroom, one for science lab—**If you were in 4th grade at TCS last year your box of pencils was kept in the lab for you to use in 5th grade**)
- 1 box Ticonderoga #2 pencils, sharpened
- 1 dry erase marker (any color)
- 1 whiteboard eraser
- 2 pairs scissors (one for classroom, one for science lab—**If you were in 4th grade at TCS last year your scissors were kept in the lab for you to use in 5th grade**)
- 1 Elmer's glue stick
- 2 rolls Scotch tape (one for classroom, one to be left in science lab)
- 1 roll duct tape for science
- 1 box Ziploc bags, can be gallon, quart, or sandwich size
- 1 bottle Tacky glue for Art
- 1 white (gum) eraser for Art
- 4 boxes tissues (3 for classroom, 1 for science)
- 1 roll paper towels for science
