

FIFTH GRADE SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT

1. Read a chapter book that you have never read before. It should have at least 175-200 pages. Please make sure the book you read is appropriate for school. Use good judgment; ask your parents. Understand that this book will be shared with the class and returned to you. Biography, historical fiction, adventure, mystery, classics, etc. are great. Do not pick comic books, horror, or books below fifth-grade level reading, please.
2. Write a summary of the book. The summary should be at least 3 paragraphs, including an introduction, body, and summarizing paragraph.
3. On a separate sheet of paper, neatly type or write 5 discussion questions. These should not be yes or no questions.
4. On another sheet of paper write your answers to the 5 questions you have written.
5. Place the book, summary page, question page, and answer page in a folder.
6. Bring the whole project with you on the first day of school.
