

# Summer Reading

## English 10

To prepare for English 10, you must complete a summer reading requirement. You will need to read and fill out a reading response chart for: ***The Great Gatsby* by F. Scott Fitzgerald.**

-Use notebook paper (or you may type it)

-Divide the page in half vertically so that you have 4 columns

Each entry (chapter) should contain:

<u>Page #</u>	<u>Quotations from text</u>	<u>Insight to main Character(s)</u>	<u>Responses</u>
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1. You must have an **entry from each chapter** of the book.
2. The **quotations** must be **written exactly** as they appear in the text – word for word and with the same punctuation as is in the text. (Be sure to use quotation marks.)
3. Your **insight** to the main character(s) is where you look at how the content of the quote is helping develop the character(s) or the plot that the character(s) is involved in.
4. Your **responses are NOT summaries** but are your observations about the text.
5. Responses **should** show **ideas/insights, reflections, questions, and comments.**
6. Responses **should** also **take note of literary elements** such as character descriptions, conflicts, settings, tone, interesting words/sentence structures, figurative language (similes, metaphors, etc.), imagery, plot twists, and irony.
7. **Each response and insight should be 3-5 sentences.**

*\*At the end of your reading response chart, include the following statements with your signature and your parent's signature:*
