HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE:** Up to **50% tuition discount** per child (*limit two children per family*)
- DURATION:** 202F – 202G school year (*ending June 30, 202G*)
- AVAILABILITY:** Approximately **20 tuition assistance packages** will be offered
- INCOME REQUIREMENTS:** Combined annual income of less than \$100,000
- STUDENT STATUS:** For families who have never enrolled at Trinity (Grades K-12 only)
- POST PROGRAM:** Participants in the *Try Trinity Tuition Assistance Program* may apply for regular tuition assistance in subsequent school years
